<p>Anne Arundel County is a local jurisdiction in the State of Maryland serving over 550,000 residents. Freetown Park is a 23 acre community park in Glen Burnie providing two athletic fields, a basketball court and tennis court, a playground and paved trails. The Department of Recreation and Parks is responsible for the operation, management, maintenance and programming of a 17,000 acre park system which includes Freetown Park. The Department also oversees the planning, design and construction of the County's park system with assistance from the Department of Public Works.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of this project is to construct a lighted picnic pavilion in Freetown Park to accommodate family and community outings and events. Freetown Park has a variety of recreation facilities to include athletic fields, basketball and tennis courts, a playground and paved trails. The proposed pavilion will provide a covered picnic area and relaxation area to complement the active recreation components.
