The school has a hall that is used by ourselves, but more importantly by various community groups, such Mission of Charity, Red Cross Blood Drive, Hope For All (H.O.P.E) nonprofit, Eagle Scouts installation, Winter Relief For Homeless - (they stay for a week and sleep in hall and are fed), Latino and Filipino Communities (celebrations, weddings, holidays), Armenian Society (cultural events), Hispanic Association for Glen Burnie, Hispanic Association of Landsdowne, Knights of Columbus, These are just a few of the groups. The hall currently has a speaker system that is not fully functioning, half of the speakers do not work and the sound board can no longer be adjusted. This same system is used by the school to announce emergencies as they happen, as well as school events. The hall is used every night by someone and the size of the groups vary from 40 to 400 depending on the event.
