AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1165
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike in their entirety the House Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB1165/942217/1).

On page 1 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute:

“State and Local Correctional Facilities – Undocumented Immigrants – Transfer to United States Department of Homeland Security (Keep Our Communities Safe Act of 2019)”;

strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 4 down through “agents” in line 11 and substitute “requiring a State or local correctional facility with custody of a certain undocumented immigrant to transfer the individual to the United States Department of Homeland Security under certain circumstances; and generally relating to undocumented immigrants and State and local correctional facilities”; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 17, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article – Correctional Services

Section 9–617

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2017 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 8 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

“Article – Correctional Services

ON REQUEST OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WITH CUSTODY OF AN UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANT WHO IS SERVING A SENTENCE IN THE FACILITY FOR CONVICTION OF A CRIME SHALL TRANSFER THE INDIVIDUAL TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.”.
