## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Department of Education and Maryland Department of Health – Maryland**  
3 **School-Based Health Center Standards – Revision**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education and the Maryland  
5 Department of Health to revise certain standards regarding Maryland school-based  
6 health centers; and generally relating to standards for school-based health centers.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
8 That, on or before August 1, 2019, the State Department of Education and the Maryland  
9 Department of Health shall revise the Maryland School-Based Health Center Standards  
10 to:

11 (1) repeal requirements for:

12 (i) a school-based health center to have a medical director who is a  
13 physician; and

14 (ii) a physician consultant to be available to the staff of the  
15 school-based health center to discuss clinical issues as needed; and
