The president and two other officers of the theater shall sign the 1 (b) (1) 2 application for the license. 3 (2) Two of the signers shall be residents of the county. 4 The Board may issue a license for use by a theater with seating [for 200 or 5 fewer individuals per performance]. 6 The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine for on-premises 7 consumption from 1 hour before to 1 hour after: 8 (1) a regular performance; or 9 (2)a fund-raiser performance that benefits the theater.
