A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B–ECF/DS Beer, Wine,**
3 **and Liquor License**

4 **PG 306–19**

5 FOR the purpose of expanding the scope of the Class B–ECF/DS beer, wine, and liquor
6 license to authorize certain individuals to hold certain events at the Prince George's
7 Community College Main Campus; specifying that the Board of License
8 Commissioners for Prince George's County may issue a Class B–ECF/DS license for
9 use only on the University of Maryland, College Park Campus or the Prince George's
10 Community College Main Campus; authorizing a license holder to sell beer, wine,
11 and liquor for on–premises consumption from multiple designated outlets on the
12 Prince George's Community College Main Campus only under certain circumstances;
13 requiring profits from the sale of alcoholic beverages sold under the license to be
14 deposited in a certain fund; requiring the Prince George's Community College Main
15 Campus to report to the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners at
16 least a certain number of days before a certain catered function; and generally
17 relating to a Class B–ECF/DS beer, wine, and liquor license in Prince George's
18 County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 26–102.

5 This title applies only in Prince George’s County.

6 26–1009.

7 (a) There is a Class B–ECF/DS (Education Conference Facility/Dining Service)
8 beer, wine, and liquor license.

9 (b) The Board may issue the license to an individual who is:

10 (1) (I) authorized by the University of Maryland, College Park Campus
11 to:

12 [(i)] 1. act on its behalf under the license; and

13 [(ii)] 2. be subject to the penalties, conditions, and restrictions
14 under this title; and

15 [(2)] (II) a resident and registered voter of the county; OR

16 (2) (I) **AUTHORIZED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COMMUNITY**
17 **COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS TO:**

18 1. **ACT ON ITS BEHALF UNDER THE LICENSE; AND**

19 2. **BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES, CONDITIONS, AND**
20 **RESTRICTIONS UNDER THIS TITLE; AND**

21 (II) **A RESIDENT AND REGISTERED VOTER OF THE COUNTY.**

22 (C) **THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A LICENSE FOR USE ONLY ON THE UNIVERSITY**
23 **OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS OR THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COMMUNITY**
24 **COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

25 [(c)] (D) (1) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and
26 liquor for on–premises consumption from multiple designated outlets on:

27 (I) the University’s campus only at University–related functions

1 catered by the Department of Dining Services; OR

2 **(II) THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S CAMPUS ONLY AT**
3 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE-RELATED FUNCTIONS CATERED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S**
4 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

5 (2) Beer, wine, and liquor purchased at a designated outlet are to be
6 consumed in the confines of that outlet and may not be transported to another outlet.

7 **[(d)] (E)** All profits from the retail sale of beer, wine, and liquor shall be
8 deposited in:

9 **(1)** the Dining Services Income Fund of the University of Maryland; OR

10 **(2) A DESIGNATED AUXILIARY SERVICES FUND OF THE PRINCE**
11 **GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

12 **[(e)] (F)** The Board:

13 (1) may regulate the manner in which beer, wine, and liquor are dispensed
14 under the license;

15 (2) before issuing the license, shall designate the exact campus locations
16 for the outlets for the sale of beer, wine, and liquor;

17 (3) shall maintain a map and description of the designated outlets for
18 verification on the renewal of the license; and

19 (4) shall require the Department of Dining Services of the University of
20 Maryland, College Park Campus **OR THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE**
21 **MAIN CAMPUS** to report to the Board at least 5 days before a University-related **OR A**
22 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE-RELATED** catered function at which beer, wine, or liquor is
23 intended to be sold or served.

24 **[(f)] (G)** The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and
25 days as set out for a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license under § 26-2004 of this title.

26 **[(g)] (H)** The annual license fee is \$8,275.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
28 1, 2019.
