## Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Basket of Cheer

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a basket of cheer permit in Frederick County; requiring 4 the Board of License Commissioners to grant the permit at no cost to holders of 5 certain Class C per diem licenses; providing that the permit authorizes the permit 6 holder to provide as a prize at a benefit performance a basket of cheer, consisting of 7 certain alcoholic beverages produced in Maryland; specifying that the alcoholic 8 beverages contained in a basket of cheer shall be for off-premises consumption; 9 requiring a holder of a permit to obtain the alcoholic beverages contained in a basket 10 of cheer from a holder of a retail license; prohibiting a permit holder from raffling off 11 more than a certain number of baskets of cheer at each benefit performance; and 12 generally relating to alcoholic beverages permits granted in Frederick County.
