A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages – Required Information on Application**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain required information in a petition of support as part
4 of an application for an alcoholic beverages license in Carroll County; and generally
5 relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

24 4–110.

1 The application shall also include a petition of support signed by at least 10 residents
2 who are owners of real estate and registered voters of the precinct in which the business is
3 to be conducted stating:

4 (1) the length of time each of the residents has been acquainted with the
5 applicant or, if the applicant is a corporation, acquainted with the individuals making the
6 application;

7 (2) that they have examined the application, have good reason to believe
8 that the statements contained in the application are true, and in their judgment the
9 applicant is a suitable person to obtain the license; and

10 (3) that they are familiar with the premises on which the proposed
11 business is to be conducted and that they believe the premises are suitable for the conduct
12 of business as a retail dealer.

14 This title applies only in Carroll County.

15 16–1401.

16 (a) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 1 (“Applications for Local Licenses”) of
17 Division I of this article apply in the county without exception or variation:

18 (1) § 4–102 (“Applications to be filed with local licensing board”);

19 (2) § 4–103 (“Application on behalf of partnership”);

20 (3) § 4–104 (“Application on behalf of corporation or club”);

21 (4) § 4–105 (“Application on behalf of limited liability company”);

22 (5) § 4–106 (“Payment of notice expenses”);

23 (6) § 4–108 (“Application form required by Comptroller”);

24 (7) [§ 4–110 (“Required information on application — Petition of support”);

25 (8)] § 4–111 (“Payment of license fees”);

26 [(9)] (8) § 4–113 (“Refund of license fees”); and

27 [(10)] (9) § 4–114 (“Fees for licenses issued for less than 1 year”).

28 (b) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 1 (“Applications for Local Licenses”) of
29 Division I of this article apply in the county:

2 16-1404 of this subtitle;

5 (3) § 4-110 (“REQUIRED INFORMATION ON APPLICATION —
6 PETITION OF SUPPORT”), SUBJECT TO § 16-1405.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

7 [(3)] (4) § 4-112 (“Disposition of license fees”), subject to § 16-1406 of this
8 subtitle.

9 **16-1405.1.**

10 AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE SHALL INCLUDE A PETITION OF SUPPORT
11 SIGNED BY AT LEAST 10 RESIDENTS WHO ARE OWNERS OF REAL ESTATE AND
12 REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE PRECINCT IN WHICH THE BUSINESS IS TO BE
13 CONDUCTED STATING:

14 (1) THE LENGTH OF TIME EACH OF THE RESIDENTS HAS BEEN
15 ACQUAINTED WITH THE APPLICANT OR, IF THE APPLICANT IS A CORPORATION,
16 ACQUAINTED WITH THE INDIVIDUALS MAKING THE APPLICATION; AND

17 (2) THAT THEY HAVE EXAMINED THE APPLICATION, HAVE GOOD
18 REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE STATEMENTS CONTAINED IN THE APPLICATION ARE
19 TRUE, AND IN THEIR JUDGMENT THE APPLICANT IS A SUITABLE PERSON TO OBTAIN
20 THE LICENSE.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2019.
