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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Insurance – Life Insurance and Annuities – Record Retention**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring insurers, except as otherwise provided in certain provisions  
4 of law, to maintain certain records for a certain minimum period of time after an  
5 individual or a group policy of life insurance or an individual or a group annuity is  
6 no longer in effect; and generally relating to the retention of records related to life  
7 insurance and annuities.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Insurance**

16 **16–120.**

17 **EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INSURER SHALL**  
18 **MAINTAIN RECORDS OF INSURANCE TRANSACTIONS RELATED TO EACH INDIVIDUAL**  
19 **OR GROUP POLICY OF LIFE INSURANCE AND EACH INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP ANNUITY**  
20 **FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 7 YEARS AFTER THE POLICY OR ANNUITY IS NO LONGER**  
21 **IN EFFECT.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
