2 **Dorchester County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class A Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester County
4 to issue a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license for a premises licensed under a
5 certain license; authorizing the Board to limit the number of Class A beer, wine, and
6 liquor licenses issued by the Board; and generally relating to the issuance of Class A
7 beer, wine, and liquor licenses in Dorchester County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 (a) The Board may issue a Class A beer license [or], Class A beer and wine
5 license, **OR CLASS A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE** for a premises licensed under
6 a Class B or Class D license.

7 (b) The Board may limit the number of Class A beer licenses [and], Class A beer
8 and wine licenses, **AND CLASS A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSES** that the Board
9 issues.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
11 1, 2019.
