1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Mandated Appropriation – City of Annapolis – Services**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a certain minimum amount for a certain annual
4 appropriation in the State budget for the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of
5 Annapolis to pay for services provided to the State by the City of Annapolis; requiring
6 that each fiscal year the annual appropriation be increased by a certain amount;
7 repealing an obsolete provision; and generally relating to a mandated appropriation
8 for the City of Annapolis.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

17 4–608.

18 (A) Annually, the State shall appropriate **IN THE STATE BUDGET** and pay to the
19 Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis [the sum provided in the State budget] **AT**
20 **LEAST \$750,000** as payment for[:

4 (B) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
5 APPROPRIATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE
6 INCREASED BY THE PERCENT INCREASE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR ALL
7 URBAN CONSUMERS FOR THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
9 1, 2019.
