1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Sunday Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the prohibition on certain license holders in Frederick County
4 selling beer, beer and wine, or beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on Sunday;
5 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales on Sunday in Frederick County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

3 (c) [(1)] A holder of a Class C beer (on–sale) license may sell beer:

4 [(i)] (1) on Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the
5 following day; and

6 [(ii)] (2) [subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection,] on Sunday:

7 [1.] (I) from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; or

8 [2.] (II) for a specific event that the Board has approved, the
9 hours for the event that are set by the Board.

10 [(2)] The license holder may not sell beer at a bar or counter on Sunday.]

11 20–2004.

12 (c) [(1)] A holder of a Class C beer and wine license may sell beer and wine:

13 [(i)] (1) on Monday through Saturday, for on–premises
14 consumption, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; and

15 [(ii)] (2) [subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection,] on Sunday,
16 for on–premises consumption:

17 [1.] (I) from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; or

18 [2.] (II) for a specific event that the Board has approved, the
19 hours for the event that are set by the Board.

20 [(2)] The license holder may not sell beer or wine at a bar or counter on
21 Sunday.]

23 (d) [(1)] A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,
24 and liquor for on– and off–premises consumption:

25 [(i)] (1) on Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the
26 following day; and

27 [(ii)] (2) [subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection,] on Sunday:

1 [1.] (I) from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; or

2 [2.] (II) for a specific event that the Board has approved, the
3 hours for the event that are set by the Board.

4 [(2) The license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor at a bar or counter
5 on Sunday.]

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2019.
