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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – Absentee Ballot Deposit Boxes**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each local board of elections to designate at least one site in  
4 the county for the location of a secure and locked deposit box for the return of  
5 absentee ballots on election day; requiring each early voting center to provide a  
6 secure and locked deposit box for the return of absentee ballots; and generally  
7 relating to the return of absentee ballots.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Election Law**

21 2–202.

22 (b) Each local board, in accordance with the provisions of this article and  
23 regulations adopted by the State Board, shall:

24 (10) maintain and dispose of its records in accordance with the plan adopted

2 (11) administer voter registration and absentee voting for nursing homes

6 LOCATION OF A SECURE AND LOCKED DEPOSIT BOX FOR THE RETURN OF ABSENTEE

9 (e) Each early voting center shall:

10 (1) satisfy the requirements of § 10–101 of this title; AND

11 (2) PROVIDE A SECURE AND LOCKED DEPOSIT BOX FOR THE RETURN  
12 OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
14 1, 2019.
