18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 9–1A–29.

3 (a) There is a Racetrack Facility Renewal Account under the authority of the
4 State Racing Commission.

5 (d) The amount of funds made available from the Racetrack Facility Renewal
6 Account shall be allocated as follows:

7 (1) 80% to the Pimlico Race Course, Laurel Park, **THE BOWIE RACE**
8 **COURSE TRAINING CENTER**, and the racecourse at Timonium; and

9 (2) 20% to Rosecroft Raceway and Ocean Downs Race Course.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2019.
