AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 699
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Automatic Expungement” and substitute “Maryland Judiciary Case Search”; in the same line, after “Marijuana” insert “Records”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “term” in line 7 and substitute “requiring the Maryland Judiciary Case Search, by a certain date, to not in any way refer to the existence of certain records relating to certain charges entered before a certain date”; in line 8, strike “expungement” and substitute “the Maryland Judiciary Case Search”; and in line 11, strike “10–105.1” and substitute “10–111”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 18 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

“10–111.

BY DECEMBER 31, 2020, THE MARYLAND JUDICIARY CASE SEARCH MAY NOT IN ANY WAY REFER TO THE EXISTENCE OF RECORDS OF DISTRICT COURT CASES WITH ELECTRONIC RECORDS RELATING TO ANY DISPOSITION OF A CHARGE OF POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA UNDER § 5–601 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE ENTERED BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2014, WHERE POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA WAS THE ONLY CHARGE IN THE CASE.”
