2 **Hunting and Fishing Licenses – Active Military, Former Prisoners of War,**  
3 **Recipients of the Purple Heart Award, and Disabled Veterans**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that the Department of Natural Resources  
5 submit ~~a certain report~~ certain reports to the Governor and the General Assembly  
6 on or before a certain date; repealing the termination ~~provision~~ provisions for certain  
7 provisions of law relating to the issuance of complimentary or discounted hunting  
8 and fishing licenses to certain military personnel, former prisoners of war, recipients  
9 of the Purple Heart Award, and disabled veterans; and generally relating to hunting  
10 and fishing licenses.

9   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 2019, the Department of Natural Resources shall report to the Governor and, in accordance  
13 with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the number of  
14 discounted angler's licenses and trout stamps, Chesapeake Bay and coastal sport fishing  
15 licenses, and hunting licenses and associated State-issued stamps and permits issued to  
16 recipients of the Purple Heart award under this Act.]

17           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
18 1, 2017. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2020,  
19 with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and  
20 of no further force and effect.]

30                   (2)   the total number of complimentary angler's licenses, recreational salt  
31 water sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued to Maryland residents under the  
32 legislation; and

33                   (3)   the total number of complimentary angler's licenses, Chesapeake Bay  
34 and coastal sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued by the Department to  
35 out-of-state persons under this Act and § 10-303(a)(2)(ii) of the Natural Resources Article.]

2 1, 2017. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2020,  
3 with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and

15 recreational salt water sport fishing license, or a hunting license to a Maryland resident  
16 who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or a 100% service connected  
17 disabled veteran;

18 (3) the total number of complimentary angler’s licenses, recreational salt  
19 water sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued to Maryland residents under the  
20 legislation; and

21 (4) the total number of complimentary angler’s licenses, Chesapeake Bay  
22 and coastal sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued by the Department to  
23 out–of–state persons under this Act and § 10–303(a)(2)(ii) of the Natural Resources Article.]
