16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 (a) (1) The Board may employ:

5 (i) one part-time chief inspector at an annual salary of ~~[\$10,000]~~
6 **\$11,000**;

7 (ii) one part-time deputy chief inspector at an annual salary of
8 ~~[\$8,000]~~ **\$9,000**; and

9 (iii) 18 part-time inspectors at an annual salary of ~~[\$6,000]~~ **\$7,000**
10 each.

11 (2) Each inspector shall receive a monthly expense allowance of \$300,
12 subject to the approval of the Comptroller.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
14 1, 2020.
