2 **Education – Certification in Secondary Education Content Areas – Expanded**
3 **Grade Range**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education, beginning in a certain school
5 year, to authorize a teacher certificated in secondary education to provide instruction
6 in the teacher’s content area to students in certain grades; requiring the State Board
7 to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to teacher certifications for
8 secondary education.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 **6–124.**

18 **(A) (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2020–2021 SCHOOL YEAR, THE STATE BOARD**
19 **SHALL AUTHORIZE A TEACHER CERTIFICATED IN SECONDARY EDUCATION TO**
20 **PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN THE TEACHER’S CONTENT AREA TO STUDENTS IN GRADES**

10 **(B) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS**
11 **SECTION.**
