1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Gaming – Home Games – Bingo**

3 FOR the purpose of adding bingo in Harford County to the list of home games that an
4 individual may conduct in a common area of a residential property under certain
5 circumstances; and generally relating to gaming.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – State Government**

14 9–1C–01.

15 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Criminal Law Article, an
16 individual who is at least 21 years old may conduct a home game involving wagering if the
17 home game:

18 (1) except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, is limited to mah
19 jong or a card game;

1 (2) is conducted not more than once a week:

2 (i) in the place of residence of an individual who may also
3 participate as a player in the home game; or

4 (ii) in a common area of a residential property that is restricted to
5 residents who are at least 55 years old;

6 (3) allows a player to compete directly against one or more other players
7 who share a preexisting social relationship;

8 (4) does not allow an individual to benefit financially in any way, directly
9 or indirectly, other than from the winnings accrued by participating as a player in the game;

10 (5) does not involve:

11 (i) a player's use of an electronic device that connects to the
12 Internet;

13 (ii) the use of paid public advertising or promotions;

14 (iii) the charging of a fee for admission, a seat, entertainment, or food
15 and drink or any other fee; or

16 (iv) the use of any money except money used for wagering; and

17 (6) has a limit of \$1,000 on the total amount of money, tokens representing
18 money, or any other thing or consideration of value that may be wagered by all players
19 during any 24-hour period.

20 (b) In Carroll County **OR IN HARFORD COUNTY**, a home game authorized under
21 subsection (a) of this section may include bingo if it is conducted in a common area of a
22 residential property that is restricted to residents who are at least 55 years old.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 October 1, 2020.
