1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That ~~the Laws of Maryland read as follows:~~

3 (a) The Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission shall  
4 coordinate with the Prince George’s County public school system to study the development  
5 of a Summer Math, Reading, and Science Pilot Program that integrates math, reading,  
6 science, technology, and social sciences content into the Commission’s summer parks and  
7 recreation programs offered in Prince George’s County.

8 (b) On or before December 1, 2020, the Commission shall report to the Prince  
9 George’s County House Delegation, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government  
10 Article, on the feasibility, cost, and potential impediments associated with implementing  
11 the Summer Math, Reading, and Science Pilot Program.

14 ~~2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE~~

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~July~~  
17 June 1, 2020. It shall remain effective for a period of ~~3 years~~ 1 year and 1 month and, at  
18 the end of June 30, ~~2023~~ 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General  
19 Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
