## A BILL ENTITLED

2 Calvert County - Criminal Law - Refusal or Failure to Leave Public Building or

Grounds

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person who has been served a certain order, warning, or

- document from refusing or failing to leave a public building or grounds, including a recreational facility or park lands, owned by Calvert County, or a specific part of a public building or grounds owned by the county under certain circumstances; and generally relating to trespassing in a public building or on public grounds.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) A person may not refuse or fail to leave a public building or grounds, or a specific part of a public building or grounds, during the time when the public building or
- grounds, or specific part of the public building or grounds, is regularly closed to the public if:
- 22 (1) the surrounding circum
  - 22 (1) the surrounding circumstances would indicate to a reasonable person
  - 23 that the person who refuses or fails to leave has no apparent lawful business to pursue at
  - 24 the public building or grounds; and



- 1 (2) a regularly employed guard, watchman, or other authorized employee 2 of the government unit that owns, operates, or maintains the public building or grounds 3 asks the person to leave.
- 4 (b) A person may not refuse or fail to leave a public building or grounds, or a specific part of a public building or grounds, during regular business hours if:
- 6 (1) the surrounding circumstances would indicate to a reasonable person 7 that the person who refuses or fails to leave:
- 8 (i) has no apparent lawful business to pursue at the public building 9 or grounds; or
- 10 (ii) is acting in a manner disruptive of and disturbing to the conduct 11 of normal business by the government unit that owns, operates, or maintains the public 12 building or grounds; and
- 13 (2) an authorized employee of the government unit asks the person to 14 leave.
- 15 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT REFUSE OR FAIL TO LEAVE A PUBLIC BUILDING OR
  16 GROUNDS, INCLUDING A RECREATIONAL FACILITY OR PARK LANDS, OR A SPECIFIC
  17 PART OF A PUBLIC BUILDING OR GROUNDS OWNED BY CALVERT COUNTY IF THE
  18 PERSON HAS BEEN SERVED A COURT ORDER, A TRESPASS WARNING, OR ANY OTHER
  19 GOVERNMENT DOCUMENT PROHIBITING THE PERSON FROM RETURNING TO THE
  20 PUBLIC BUILDING OR GROUNDS, OR A SPECIFIC PART OF THE BUILDING OR
  21 GROUNDS, AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION.
- [(c)] (D) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
