A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Housing and Community Development – Shelter and Transitional Housing**
3 **Facilities Grant Program – Mandated Funding**

4 FOR the purpose of altering, beginning in a certain fiscal year and for each fiscal year
5 thereafter, the amount the Governor is required to include in the annual budget bill
6 or the capital budget bill for the Shelter and Transitional Housing Facilities Grant
7 Program within the Department of Housing and Community Development; and
8 generally relating to funding for shelters and transitional housing facilities.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Housing and Community Development**

17 4–216.

18 **(A)** For **EACH OF** fiscal [year 2018 and each fiscal year thereafter,] **YEARS 2018**
19 **THROUGH 2021**, the Governor shall include in the annual budget bill or the capital budget
20 bill an appropriation of \$3,000,000 from general funds or the proceeds from the sale of State
21 general obligation bonds for the Shelter and Transitional Housing Facilities Grant
22 Program.

23 **(B)** **FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE**
24 **GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL OR THE CAPITAL BUDGET**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$5,000,000 FROM GENERAL FUNDS OR THE PROCEEDS**
2 **FROM THE SALE OF STATE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE SHELTER AND**
3 **TRANSITIONAL HOUSING FACILITIES GRANT PROGRAM.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2020.
