A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Salaries of Inspectors**

3 FOR the purpose of raising the salaries of the chief inspector, deputy chief inspector, and
4 other inspectors employed by the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel
5 County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 11–102.

20 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

5 (iii) 18 part-time inspectors at an annual salary of ~~[\$6,000]~~ **\$7,000**

7 (2) Each inspector shall receive a monthly expense allowance of \$300,
8 subject to the approval of the Comptroller.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2020.
