1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Career Exploration and Development Activities – Coffee**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing an Executive Branch agency to ban or regulate the sale of  
4 coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity in a public  
5 high school in Frederick County; providing a certain exception; and generally  
6 relating to the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and  
7 development activity in public high schools in Frederick County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (a) This section applies only in Baltimore County **AND FREDERICK COUNTY**.

18 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an Executive Branch

2 (c) An Executive Branch agency may not ban or regulate the sale of coffee in
