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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Barbershop and Beauty Salon License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a barbershop and beauty salon beer and wine license in  
4 Harford County; authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a  
5 license to a holder of certain business permits; authorizing the holder of the license  
6 to serve certain amounts of beer and wine for on–premises consumption to an  
7 individual in a single day under certain circumstances; prohibiting the license from  
8 being transferred to another location; setting the hours of operation for the license;  
9 authorizing a license holder to purchase alcoholic beverages from a wholesaler or a  
10 retailer; requiring a license holder to comply with certain record–keeping provisions  
11 and certain alcohol awareness training requirements; establishing an annual license  
12 fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 7 That Section(s) 22–1001 of Article – Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland  
 8 be renumbered to be Section(s) 22–1001.1.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read  
 10 as follows:

11 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

12 22–102.

13 This title applies only in Harford County.

14 **22–1001.**

15 **(A) THERE IS A BARBERSHOP AND BEAUTY SALON BEER AND WINE LICENSE.**

16 **(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF:**

17 **(1) A BARBERSHOP PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 4–501 OF THE BUSINESS**  
 18 **OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR**

19 **(2) A BEAUTY SALON PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 5–501 OF THE**  
 20 **BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.**

21 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO PROVIDE, ~~BY SALE~~**  
 22 **~~OR SERVED AT NO COST,~~ TO A PARTICIPATING INDIVIDUAL NOT MORE THAN ~~TWO~~**  
 23 **ONE 12–OUNCE SERVINGS SERVING OF BEER OR ~~TWO~~ ONE 5–OUNCE SERVINGS**  
 24 **SERVING OF WINE BY THE GLASS FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION IN A SINGLE DAY**  
 25 **WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL:**

26 **(1) IS PROVIDED A SERVICE UNDER § 4–501 OR § 5–501 OF THE**  
 27 **BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR**

28 **(2) IS ATTENDING A FUND–RAISING EVENT AT THE BARBERSHOP OR**  
 29 **BEAUTY SALON FOR WHICH THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS,**  
 30 **LICENSES, AND PERMITS HAS ISSUED A PERMIT.**

1           **(D) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.**

2           **(E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PROVIDE BEER AND WINE FOR**  
3 **ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS BUT NOT LATER**  
4 **THAN 9 P.M.**

5           **(F) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM A**  
6 **WHOLESALE OR FROM A RETAILER.**

7           **(G) AN ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED IS SUBJECT TO:**

8                   **(1) THE RECORD-KEEPING PROVISIONS UNDER § 22-1904 OF THIS**  
9 **TITLE; AND**

10                   **(2) THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER §**  
11 **4-505 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

12           **(H) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$400.**

13           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
14 1, 2020.
