## Behavioral Health - Opioid Treatment Services Programs - Medical Director

- 2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OPIOID TREATMENT SERVICES PROGRAM" HAS THE 3 MEANING STATED IN § 21–2A–01 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 4 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH OPIOID 5 TREATMENT SERVICES PROGRAM SHALL BE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF AT LEAST 6 ONE ON–SITE MEDICAL DIRECTOR.
- 7 (2) THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 8 THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ON-SITE AT THE OPIOID TREATMENT SERVICES 9 PROGRAM AT LEAST 20 HOURS EACH WEEK.
- 10 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, AN OPIOID 11 TREATMENT SERVICES PROGRAM MAY NOT SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER 12 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION THROUGH TELEHEALTH.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
