A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes – Unattended Dogs in Extreme Weather Conditions**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from leaving a dog outside and unattended for
4 longer than a certain period without access to certain suitable shelter during certain
5 extreme weather conditions; making a certain violation a civil offense; establishing
6 certain penalties; defining certain terms; and generally relating to leaving
7 unattended dogs outside.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Law**

16 10–623.

17 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

18 (2) “Collar” means a device constructed of nylon, leather, or similar
19 material specifically designed to be used around the neck of a dog.

20 (3) **“EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS” MEANS TEMPERATURES**
21 **BELOW 32 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT OR ABOVE 90 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT, OR DURING**
22 **AN ACTIVE WEATHER WARNING ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) “Restraint” means a chain, rope, tether, leash, cable, or other
2 device that attaches a dog to a stationary object or trolley system.

3 (5) (I) **“SUITABLE SHELTER” MEANS A STRUCTURE THAT:**

4 1. **IS PROPERLY VENTILATED;**

5 2. **HAS A SOLID FLOOR THAT IS RAISED OFF THE GROUND**
6 **AT LEAST 2 INCHES;**

7 3. **HAS A WEATHERPROOF ROOF;**

8 4. **HAS FOUR WALLS, ONE OF WHICH CONTAINS A**
9 **DOORWAY;**

10 5. **HAS INSULATION OR HEATING SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW**
11 **A DOG TO MAINTAIN ITS NORMAL BODY TEMPERATURE; AND**

12 6. **IS SUITABLE FOR THE SPECIES, AGE, CONDITION,**
13 **SIZE, AND TYPE OF DOG.**

14 (II) **“SUITABLE SHELTER” DOES NOT INCLUDE:**

15 1. **A CRAWL SPACE THAT IS UNDER A BUILDING OR PART**
16 **OF A BUILDING;**

17 2. **THE SPACE UNDER A VEHICLE;**

18 3. **A FLOOR CONSISTING OF WIRE OR CHAIN LINK; OR**

19 4. **A STRUCTURE MADE FROM CARDBOARD OR OTHER**
20 **MATERIALS THAT ARE EASILY DEGRADED BY THE ELEMENTS.**

21 (b) A person may not leave a dog outside and unattended by use of a restraint:

22 (1) that unreasonably limits the movement of the dog;

23 (2) that uses a collar that:

24 (i) is made primarily of metal; or

25 (ii) is not at least as large as the circumference of the dog’s neck plus
26 1 inch;

1 (3) that restricts the access of the dog to suitable and sufficient clean water
2 or appropriate shelter;

3 (4) in unsafe or unsanitary conditions; or

4 (5) that causes injury to the dog.

5 **(C) A PERSON MAY NOT LEAVE A DOG OUTSIDE AND UNATTENDED FOR**
6 **LONGER THAN 30 MINUTES WITHOUT ACCESS TO CONTINUOUS SUITABLE SHELTER**
7 **DURING EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS.**

8 **[(c)] (D) (1) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A CIVIL OFFENSE.**

9 **(2) A person who violates this section is [guilty of a misdemeanor and on**
10 **conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 90 days or a fine not exceeding \$1,000**
11 **or both] SUBJECT TO:**

12 **(I) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A WARNING;**

13 **(II) FOR A SECOND VIOLATION, A \$500 FINE; OR**

14 **(III) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A \$1,000 FINE.**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2020.
