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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County – Property Tax Credit – Public Safety Officers**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Charles County to grant, by law, a  
4 property tax credit against the county property tax imposed on a dwelling located in  
5 the county that is owned by a certain public safety officer; requiring the credit to  
6 equal a certain percentage of the property tax imposed on the dwelling; authorizing  
7 the governing body of Charles County to provide, by law, for certain matters relating  
8 to the credit; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and  
9 generally relating to a property tax credit for public safety officers in Charles County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **(L) (1) (I) IN THIS SUBSECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE**  
20 **MEANINGS INDICATED.**

21 **(II) “DWELLING” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9–105 OF THIS**  
22 **TITLE.**

23 **(III) “PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER” MEANS:**

1                   **1. A POLICE OFFICER OR DEPUTY SHERIFF EMPLOYED**  
2 **FULL TIME BY A PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY IN CHARLES COUNTY OR A MUNICIPAL**  
3 **CORPORATION IN CHARLES COUNTY; OR**

4                   **2. A MARYLAND STATE POLICE OFFICER WHO IS**  
5 **ASSIGNED TO WORK FULL TIME IN CHARLES COUNTY.**

6                   **(2) THE GOVERNING BODY OF CHARLES COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY**  
7 **LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY**  
8 **PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON A DWELLING LOCATED IN THE COUNTY THAT IS OWNED**  
9 **BY A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE CREDIT UNDER § 9-105 OF**  
10 **THIS TITLE.**

11                   **(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL EQUAL**  
12 **50% OF THE PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON THE DWELLING.**

13                   **(4) THE GOVERNING BODY OF CHARLES COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH, BY**  
14 **LAW:**

15                   **(I) THE DURATION OF THE CREDIT;**

16                   **(II) ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC**  
17 **SAFETY OFFICERS TO QUALIFY FOR THE CREDIT;**

18                   **(III) PROCEDURES FOR THE APPLICATION AND UNIFORM**  
19 **PROCESSING OF REQUESTS FOR THE CREDIT; AND**

20                   **(IV) ANY OTHER PROVISIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS**  
21 **SECTION.**

22                   **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June**  
23 **1, 2020, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2020.**
