## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Civil Claim Against Private Police – Prohibition Against**  
3 **Nondisclosure Provision in Settlement Agreement**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use or enforcement of a confidentiality or other  
5 nondisclosure provision in a settlement agreement or other release of liability  
6 between the parties in a claim of misconduct in the performance of duties against a  
7 law enforcement officer of a private law enforcement agency in Baltimore City;  
8 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to private law  
9 enforcement agencies.

11 Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

18 **5–644.**

19 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A CLAIM OR SUIT ARISING IN**  
20 **BALTIMORE CITY.**

21 **(B) FOR A CLAIM OR SUIT ASSERTING MISCONDUCT IN THE PERFORMANCE**  
22 **OF DUTIES BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF A PRIVATE LAW ENFORCEMENT**  
23 **AGENCY, A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OR ANY GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY**  
24 **BETWEEN THE PARTIES MAY NOT CONTAIN, AND A COURT MAY NOT ENFORCE, A**

1 **CONFIDENTIALITY OR OTHER NONDISCLOSURE PROVISION.**

2           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to  
3 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or  
4 application to any agreement or release of liability executed before the effective date of this  
5 Act.

6           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2020.
