A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Insurance Administration – Pharmacy Services Administrative**
3 **Organizations – Regulation**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, on or after a certain date, pharmacy services administrative
5 organizations to register with the Maryland Insurance Commissioner before
6 providing certain services in the State; requiring certain applicants to file an
7 application on a certain form and pay a certain fee; providing for the expiration and
8 renewal of a certain registration; prohibiting certain pharmacy services
9 administrative organizations from entering into certain contracts; authorizing the
10 Commissioner to deny, refuse to renew, suspend, or revoke a registration under
11 certain circumstances; requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization to
12 maintain certain books and records in a certain manner and for a certain time period;
13 authorizing the Commissioner to examine the affairs, transactions, accounts, and
14 records of a registered pharmacy services administrative organization; requiring
15 that the examination be conducted, the expense of the examination be paid, and the
16 reports be issued in accordance with certain laws; authorizing and requiring the
17 Commissioner to adopt certain regulations; prohibiting certain contracts and
18 amendments to certain contracts from becoming effective except under certain
19 circumstances; requiring a pharmacy services administrative contract to include a
20 certain provision requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization to
21 provide certain documents and information to a certain pharmacy within a certain
22 period of time; requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization to disclose
23 certain information concerning certain ownership or control to the Commissioner
24 and notify the Commissioner of certain changes in ownership or control within a
25 certain period of time; requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization to
26 provide certain disclosures before entering into certain contracts with certain
27 entities; requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization to provide notice
28 of certain changes in ownership or control to certain entities within a certain period
29 of time; requiring a certain contract that authorizes a pharmacy benefits manager to
30 conduct a certain audit of a pharmacy services administrative organization to
31 contain certain language that authorizes the pharmacy benefits manager to obtain

1 certain information regarding certain pharmacies for certain purposes; requiring a
2 pharmacy services administrative contract to require certain remittances to be
3 passed from a pharmacy services administrative organization to a certain pharmacy
4 within a certain period of time; requiring a pharmacy services administrative
5 organization to submit a certain annual report to the Commissioner under certain
6 circumstances; requiring the Commissioner to make certain reports available to the
7 public; prohibiting a pharmacy services administrative organization from requiring
8 a certain pharmacy to purchase certain drugs, biologics, or medical devices from a
9 certain entity as a condition for entering into a pharmacy services administrative
10 contract; requiring a pharmacy services administrative organization that owns or is
11 owned by a certain entity to disclose to the Commissioner certain agreements;
12 requiring certain disclosures to comply with certain privacy standards; requiring
13 certain pharmacy services administrative organizations to establish certain policies
14 and procedures; establishing certain prohibited acts; authorizing the Commissioner
15 to issue certain cease and desist orders, take certain action, and impose certain
16 penalties under certain circumstances; providing for the service of a certain order;
17 providing that a request for a certain hearing does not stay a certain portion of a
18 certain order; authorizing the Commissioner to file a certain petition in a certain
19 court and to recover certain fees and costs under certain circumstances; providing
20 that certain provisions of this Act do not limit certain regulatory authority; providing
21 for the construction of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to
22 pharmacy services administrative organizations.

29 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

37 THE STATE THAT IS UNDER COMMON OWNERSHIP WITH NOT MORE THAN TWO
38 OTHER PHARMACIES.

1 (IX) MARKETING SUPPORT;

2 (X) PAYMENT AND DRUG DISPENSING DATA MANAGEMENT AND
3 ANALYSIS; OR

4 (XI) PROVISION OF RESOURCES FOR RETAIL CASH CARDS.

5 (F) (1) "THIRD-PARTY PAYER" MEANS AN ENTITY OPERATING WITHIN
6 THE STATE THAT PAYS OR INSURES HEALTH, MEDICAL, OR PRESCRIPTION DRUG
7 EXPENSES ON BEHALF OF BENEFICIARIES.

8 (2) "THIRD-PARTY PAYER" INCLUDES A PLAN SPONSOR, A
9 NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION, AND
10 AN INSURER.

11 (3) "THIRD-PARTY PAYER" DOES NOT INCLUDE A SELF-FUNDED
12 EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT INCOME SECURITY ACT OF 1974 (ERISA) PLAN AS
13 DESCRIBED IN 29 U.S.C. § 1144(B)(2)(B).

15 (A) ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2021, A PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE
16 ORGANIZATION SHALL REGISTER WITH THE COMMISSIONER AS A PHARMACY
17 SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION BEFORE PROVIDING SERVICES AS A
18 PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION IN THE STATE TO
19 INDEPENDENT PHARMACIES.

21 (1) FILE WITH THE COMMISSIONER AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM

27 (4) VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE OR A REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER
28 THIS SUBTITLE.

1 ADEQUATE BOOKS AND RECORDS REGARDING EACH INDEPENDENT PHARMACY FOR

3 SERVICES AS A PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION:

7 **RELATE TO AN ISSUE IN A COMPLAINT OR AN APPEAL OF A DECISION REGARDING A**
8 **COMPLAINT;**

9 **(2) REFUSE TO PAY OR REIMBURSE AN INDEPENDENT PHARMACY OR**
10 **A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER FOR AN ARBITRARY OR CAPRICIOUS REASON**
11 **BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE INFORMATION;**

12 **(3) FAIL TO SETTLE A DISPUTE PROMPTLY WHENEVER LIABILITY IS**
13 **REASONABLY CLEAR UNDER ONE PART OF A POLICY OR CONTRACT, IN ORDER TO**
14 **INFLUENCE SETTLEMENTS UNDER OTHER PARTS OF THE POLICY OR CONTRACT; OR**

15 **(4) FAIL TO ACT IN GOOD FAITH.**

16 **(B) IF THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES THAT A PHARMACY SERVICES**
17 **ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION HAS VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE**
18 **OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSIONER MAY**
19 **ISSUE AN ORDER THAT REQUIRES A PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE**
20 **ORGANIZATION TO:**

21 **(1) CEASE AND DESIST FROM THE IDENTIFIED VIOLATION AND**
22 **FURTHER SIMILAR VIOLATIONS;**

23 **(2) TAKE SPECIFIC AFFIRMATIVE ACTION TO CORRECT THE**
24 **VIOLATION;**

25 **(3) MAKE RESTITUTION OF MONEY, PROPERTY, AND OTHER ASSETS**
26 **TO A PERSON THAT HAS SUFFERED FINANCIAL INJURY BECAUSE OF THE VIOLATION;**
27 **OR**

28 **(4) PAY A FINE IN THE AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE**
29 **COMMISSIONER.**

30 **(C) (1) AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION**

1 MAY BE SERVED ON A PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION THAT
2 IS REGISTERED UNDER § 15-2002 OF THIS SUBTITLE IN THE MANNER PROVIDED IN
3 § 2-204 OF THIS ARTICLE.

4 (2) AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION
5 MAY BE SERVED ON A PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION THAT
6 IS NOT REGISTERED UNDER § 15-2002 OF THIS SUBTITLE IN THE MANNER PROVIDED
7 IN § 4-206 OR § 4-207 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR SERVICE ON AN UNAUTHORIZED
8 INSURER THAT DOES AN ACT OF INSURANCE BUSINESS IN THE STATE.

9 (3) A REQUEST FOR A HEARING ON ANY ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS
10 SECTION DOES NOT STAY THAT PORTION OF THE ORDER THAT REQUIRES THE
11 PHARMACY SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION TO CEASE AND DESIST
12 FROM THE CONDUCT IDENTIFIED IN THE ORDER.

13 (4) THE COMMISSIONER MAY FILE A PETITION IN THE CIRCUIT
14 COURT OF ANY COUNTY TO ENFORCE AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION,
15 WHETHER OR NOT A HEARING HAS BEEN REQUESTED OR, IF REQUESTED, WHETHER
16 OR NOT A HEARING HAS BEEN HELD.

17 (5) IF THE COMMISSIONER PREVAILS IN AN ACTION BROUGHT UNDER
18 THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER MAY RECOVER, FOR THE USE OF THE STATE,
19 REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEES AND THE COSTS OF THE ACTION.

20 (D) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER ENFORCEMENT ACTION TAKEN BY THE
21 COMMISSIONER UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL
22 PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

23 (E) THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS:

24 (1) TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION; AND

25 (2) TO ESTABLISH A COMPLAINT PROCESS TO ADDRESS GRIEVANCES
26 AND APPEALS BROUGHT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

27 (F) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT ANY OTHER REGULATORY AUTHORITY
28 OF THE COMMISSIONER UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
