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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Transfer Tax – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of extending to a certain date the termination provision relating to the  
4 authority of the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to impose a transfer tax  
5 on certain instruments of writing; and generally relating to the transfer tax in St.  
6 Mary's County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County  
9 Section 138–1B.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 19 – St. Mary's County**

2 B. The County Commissioners may impose a transfer tax on an instrument of  
3 writing:

4 (1) Recorded with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County; or

5 (2) Filed with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation.

6 F. The authority granted to impose a transfer tax under this section shall  
7 terminate and be of no effect after [July 1, 2020] **OCTOBER 1, 2024**.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
9 1, 2020.
