CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Schools – Provision of Menstrual Hygiene Products – Requirement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to ensure that each public
4 school provide, at no charge to students, menstrual hygiene products via dispensers
5 in the restrooms at the school; requiring a public middle or high school to install
6 menstrual hygiene product dispensers in certain restrooms by certain dates;
7 requiring a public elementary school to install menstrual hygiene product dispensers
8 in at least one restroom by a certain date; defining a certain term; and generally
9 relating to the provision of menstrual hygiene products in public schools.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **7–447.**

19 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “MENSTRUAL HYGIENE PRODUCTS” MEANS**

1 SIZE-APPROPRIATE TAMPONS OR SANITARY NAPKINS FOR USE IN CONNECTION
2 WITH THE MENSTRUAL CYCLE.

3 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, EACH COUNTY BOARD
4 SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL PROVIDE, AT NO CHARGE TO STUDENTS,
5 MENSTRUAL HYGIENE PRODUCTS VIA DISPENSERS IN THE RESTROOMS AT THE
6 SCHOOL.

7 (C) (1) A PUBLIC MIDDLE OR HIGH SCHOOL SHALL INSTALL MENSTRUAL
8 HYGIENE PRODUCT DISPENSERS IN:

9 (I) AT LEAST TWO RESTROOMS ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1,
10 2021; AND

11 (II) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2025:

12 1. IF THE RESTROOMS ARE DIVIDED BY GENDER:

13 A. AT LEAST ONE MEN’S RESTROOM; AND

14 B. ALL WOMEN’S RESTROOMS; OR

15 2. IF THE RESTROOMS ARE NOT DIVIDED BY GENDER,
16 ALL RESTROOMS.

17 (2) A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SHALL INSTALL MENSTRUAL
18 HYGIENE PRODUCT DISPENSERS IN AT LEAST ONE RESTROOM ON OR BEFORE
19 OCTOBER 1, 2021.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
21 1, 2021.
