 7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES.**

23 **(B) (1) WITHIN THE FIRST 12 MONTHS OF EMPLOYMENT, A NEW OFFICER**
 24 **OF A HUMANE SOCIETY OR ANIMAL CONTROL SHALL SATISFACTORILY COMPLETE AT**
 25 **LEAST 80 HOURS OF TRAINING FOR ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL PROFESSIONALS**
 26 **THAT IS APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE UNIT OF A COUNTY OR ~~MUNICIPAL~~**
 27 **CORPORATION MUNICIPALITY.**

28 **(2) THE TRAINING SHALL INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON:**

29 **(I) ANIMAL CRUELTY INVESTIGATIONS;**

5 (V) PROFESSIONALISM AND ETHICAL STANDARDS;

6 (VI) EVIDENCE COLLECTION AND THE CHAIN OF CUSTODY;

7 (VII) PREPARATION FOR CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS,
8 INCLUDING BASIC TRIAL PRINCIPLES AND DUE PROCESS PROTECTIONS;

9 (VIII) CONFLICT RESOLUTION AND OFFICER SAFETY, INCLUDING
10 PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH; AND

11 (IX) ANIMAL DISEASES AND ZONOSIS.

12 (3) THE UNIT OF THE COUNTY OR ~~MUNICIPAL CORPORATION~~
13 MUNICIPALITY MAY REQUIRE OTHER TRAINING IN ADDITION TO THE TRAINING
14 SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

15 ~~(2) (B) (C)~~ (1) AN OFFICER OF A HUMANE SOCIETY OR ANIMAL CONTROL
16 SHALL SATISFACTORILY COMPLETE AT LEAST 6 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
17 APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE UNIT OF A COUNTY OR ~~MUNICIPAL CORPORATION~~
18 MUNICIPALITY EVERY YEAR.

19 (2) THE CONTINUING EDUCATION SHALL INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON
20 THE CURRENT LAWS APPLICABLE TO OFFICERS.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2021.
