- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing the State song; requiring the Maryland State Arts Council to 4 develop a plan for and conduct a certain State song competition, including the 5 acceptance of certain entries to the competition, and to carry out certain tasks 6 relating to the competition; requiring the Council to report certain finalists of the 7 competition to the Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly on or 8 before a certain date; authorizing the Council to make certain recommendations; 9 providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating 10 to the State song.

6	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:				
7	(a) The Maryland State Arts Council shall:				
8 9 10	(1) (i) develop a plan for and conduct a State song competition in which contestants, either individually or as a group, may submit to the Council a song about the State of Maryland; and				
11 12 13	(ii) include and accept as entries to the State song competition the proposed replacement songs that originated out of the October 2015 report of the State Song Advisory Group and are designated in the following bills:				
14	1. S.B. 49/H.B. 215 of 2016; and				
15	2. H.B. 608 of 2018;				
16 17	(2) develop rules and guidelines for the State song competition, including the acceptance of entries that alter only the song lyrics or both the song lyrics and music;				
18 19	(3) develop criteria for the selection of a competition winner or finalists, including the recommendations of the State Song Advisory Group that:				
20 21	(i) the song shall be an original song that is written and composed by the contestant;				
22 23	(ii) the song shall be dignified, singable, and evoke visual images of Maryland's history, diversity, and natural beauty; and				
24 25	(iii) the contestant shall agree to surrender to the State any copyrights to the song's composition, arrangement, or lyrics;				
26 27 28	(4) select no more than three finalists from the entries to the State song competition that complied with competition rules and guidelines, giving preference to contestants who are residents of the State; and				
29 30	(5) promote the State song competition on the Maryland State Arts Council website and through media outlets.
