A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Officers' Retirement System – Kent County**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System
4 for certain local detention center officers of Kent County under certain
5 circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to eligibility service and
6 creditable service that was earned before the effective date of Kent County's
7 participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System; providing that an
8 individual who receives certain service credit is not a member of and has no rights
9 to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing for the transfer of creditable
10 service for a certain individual; providing for the transfer and crediting of certain
11 assets on the effective date of participation; and generally relating to Kent County's
12 participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

21 **31–2B–07.**

22 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LOCAL DETENTION**
23 **CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO**
24 **REMAINS A LOCAL DETENTION CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY THROUGH THE**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF KENT COUNTY
3 BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE CORRECTIONAL
4 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS'
5 RETIREMENT SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER
6 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

7 (C) IF KENT COUNTY COMMENCES PARTICIPATION IN THE CORRECTIONAL
8 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS
9 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS
10 ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE SERVICE IN THE
11 CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH KENT
12 COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 (D) ON JOINING THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM
14 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
15 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
16 SHALL:

17 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION
18 SYSTEM; AND

19 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES'
20 PENSION SYSTEM.

21 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL
22 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE
23 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO
24 TRANSFERS TO THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER THIS
25 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE 37 OF THIS ARTICLE.

26 (F) IF KENT COUNTY BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN
27 THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, § 31-2B-05(C) OF THIS
28 SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF ASSETS ON THE
29 EFFECTIVE DATE.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
31 1, 2021.
