CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Family Law – Marriage – Licenses and Records**

3 FOR the purpose of altering certain designations on a marriage license and certificate;
4 authorizing the clerk of the circuit court to maintain a certain electronic record as
5 an alternative to the requirement that the clerk keep a certain marriage license book;
6 and generally relating to marriage.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Family Law**

15 2–403.

16 (a) (1) A license shall read substantially as follows:

17 “State of Maryland and County of To any individual authorized by the laws
18 of this State to perform a marriage ceremony. You are hereby authorized to join together

11 (2) A license shall contain:

12 (i) appropriate spaces in which the clerk shall enter:

- 13 1. the relationship of the parties to be married, if any; and
- 14 2. as to each party, the name, age, state or foreign country in
15 which born, residence, and marital status (single, widowed, or divorced); and

16 (ii) a statement that the license is valid only:

- 17 1. for 6 months from the effective date and time stated on the
18 license; and
- 19 2. in the county in which it is issued.

20 (b) (1) Attached to a license shall be 2 certificate forms that:

21 (i) read, “I hereby certify that on this day of (state
22 here month and year), (state here time), at (state here location), in
23 accordance with the license issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for (state
24 here jurisdiction), I united in marriage the following individuals:

31 (ii) restate all information concerning the individuals married that
32 is stated on the marriage license; and

33 (iii) provide a space for the signature of the authorized official who

1 performs the marriage ceremony.

2 (2) Attached to a license, in the case of a Society of Friends marriage
3 ceremony, shall be 2 certificate forms that:

4 (i) read, “We hereby certify that on this day of (state
5 here month and year), (state here time), at (state here location), we,
6 (state here name of [husband] **PARTY ONE**) and (state here name of [wife] **PARTY**
7 **TWO**) were united in marriage in accordance with the ceremony of the Society of Friends
8 and in accordance with the license issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for (state
9 here jurisdiction)”;

10 (ii) restate all information concerning the individuals married that
11 is stated on the marriage license; and

12 (iii) provide spaces for the signatures of the parties and the 2
13 overseers of the marriage ceremony.

14 2–501.

15 Each clerk shall keep in the clerk’s office a marriage license book **OR ELECTRONIC**
16 **RECORD**, which shall contain:

17 (1) a complete record of each license issued;

18 (2) a complete record of all matters the clerk is required to ascertain that
19 relate to the rights of an individual to obtain a license;

20 (3) in regular order, the items testified to by the applicants for a license as
21 required under this title;

22 (4) properly indexed, the name of each individual who intends to be
23 married; and

24 (5) the date each certificate was filed and the name of the authorized
25 official who performed the ceremony.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2021.
