1 AN ACT concerning

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- FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "purchaser" for the purposes of certain provisions of State insurance law governing pharmacy benefits managers to repeal the exclusion of certain persons that provide prescription drug coverage or benefits
- through plans subject to ERISA; repealing a certain definition; and generally relating to pharmacy benefits managers and plans subject to ERISA.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Insurance
- 16 15–1601.
- 17 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 18 (b) "Agent" means a pharmacy, a pharmacist, a mail order pharmacy, or a 19 nonresident pharmacy acting on behalf or at the direction of a pharmacy benefits manager.
- 20 (c) "Beneficiary" means an individual who receives prescription drug coverage or 21 benefits from a purchaser.
- (c-1) "Compensation program" means a program, policy, or process through which sources and pricing information are used by a pharmacy benefits manager to determine the



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

"Pharmacy" has the meaning stated in § 12–101 of the Health Occupations 4 (i) 5 Article. 6 "Pharmacy and therapeutics committee" means a committee established by a 7 pharmacy benefits manager to: 8 (1) objectively appraise and evaluate prescription drugs; and 9 **(2)** make recommendations to a purchaser regarding the selection of drugs for the purchaser's formulary. 10 11 (1)(1) "Pharmacy benefits management services" means: 12 the procurement of prescription drugs at a negotiated rate for dispensation within the State to beneficiaries; 13 14 (ii) the administration or management of prescription drug coverage provided by a purchaser for beneficiaries; and 15 16 any of the following services provided with regard to the (iii) 17 administration of prescription drug coverage: 18 1. mail service pharmacy; 19 2. claims processing, retail network management, and payment of claims to pharmacies for prescription drugs dispensed to beneficiaries; 2021 clinical formulary development and management services; 3. 22 rebate contracting and administration; 4. 23 5. patient compliance, therapeutic intervention, and generic 24substitution programs; or 256. disease management programs. "Pharmacy benefits management services" does not include any service 26 27 provided by a nonprofit health maintenance organization that operates as a group model, 28provided that the service:
- 29 (i) is provided solely to a member of the nonprofit health 30 maintenance organization; and



- 1 with § 12–504 of the Health Occupations Article; or
- 2 (v) a change required for coverage reasons because the originally 3 prescribed drug is not covered by the beneficiary's formulary or plan.
- 4 (r) "Therapeutic interchange solicitation" means any communication by a 5 pharmacy benefits manager for the purpose of requesting a therapeutic interchange.
- 6 (s) "Trade secret" has the meaning stated in § 11–1201 of the Commercial Law 7 Article.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2021.
