AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 394
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and West**” and substitute “**West, Klausmeier, and Benson**”; in lines 3 and 7, in each instance, strike “dispense” and substitute “offer”; in line 7, after “circumstances;” insert “requiring the Maryland Department of Health to purchase and provide naloxone to certain providers, subject to a certain limitation; authorizing certain entities to provide naloxone only under certain circumstances;”; in line 10, strike “dispensing” and substitute “offering”; and in line 18, after “8-408” insert “and 13-3103(d)”.

On page 2, in line 3, strike “13-3104, 13-3108,” and substitute “13-3108”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 18, strike “**DISPENSE**” and substitute “**OFFER**”.

On page 3, in lines 7 and 8, strike “**: (I) A**” and substitute “**A**”; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through “**PROGRAM**” in line 11; in line 13, strike “**HUMAN SERVICES**” and substitute “**HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**”; strike beginning with “**IN**” in line 15 down through “**7.01.19.01**” in line 16; in line 24, strike “**COMAR 10.47.02.11**” and substitute “**REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT**”; and strike in their entirety lines 25 through 27, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 1, strike “**DISPENSE OR MAKE AVAILABLE**” and substitute “**OFFER**”; and after line 4, insert:

“(C) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2023, EACH OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM AND EACH INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM SHALL HAVE A

PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES SERVICES FROM THE OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM OR INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM.

(D) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2024:

(1) STATE AND LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES SHALL HAVE A PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, TO SENTENCED INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE AN OPIOID USE DISORDER OR WHO ARE AT RISK OF EXPERIENCING A DRUG OVERDOSE BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL'S RELEASE; AND

(2) THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION SHALL HAVE A PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER SUPERVISION WHO HAVE AN OPIOID USE DISORDER OR ARE AT RISK OF EXPERIENCING A DRUG OVERDOSE.

(E) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 9, insert:

"13-3103.

(D) (1) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE BUDGET, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PURCHASE AND PROVIDE NALOXONE, AT NO COST, TO THE PROVIDERS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO OFFER NALOXONE UNDER § 8-408 OR § 19-310.3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(2) AN ENTITY REQUIRED TO OFFER NALOXONE UNDER § 8-408 OR § 19-310.3 OF THIS ARTICLE MAY PROVIDE THE NALOXONE ONLY IF THE NALOXONE IS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.;

and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 23, inclusive.

On page 5, in line 25, strike “**2024**” and substitute “**2023**”; and in the same line, strike “**DISPENSING**” and substitute “**OFFERING**”.

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 29 on page 5 through line 3 on page 6, inclusive.
