AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 985

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after “Attar,” insert “Atterbeary,”; in the same line, after “Grammer,” insert “Griffith,”; in the same line, after “Harrison,” insert “Hartman,”; in lines 2 and 3, strike “**and Graduation Requirement**”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 7 down through “school;” in line 8 and substitute “repealing a provision of law requiring the State Department of Education to report on certain changes to financial literacy curricula at a certain interval;”; in line 9, strike “that is required for graduation from a” and substitute “for”; in line 10, strike “school” and substitute “schools”; after line 10, insert:

“BY repealing

Article - Education

Section 4-111.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement)”;

after line 15, insert:

“SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 4-111.1 of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.”;

in line 16, strike “1.” and substitute “2. AND”; in the same line, after “IT” insert “FURTHER”; and in the same line, strike “BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 3, strike “**HALF-SEMESTER-LONG**” and substitute “HALF-CREDIT”; in line 4, after “(B)” insert “THE COURSE DEVELOPED BY THE STATE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE INSTRUCTIONAL CONTENT BASED ON THE STATE”
