 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35

of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 1 2 or compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset County, the State's Attorney for Somerset 3 County, the Chief Judge of the Orphans' Court for Somerset County, an associate judge of 4 the Orphans' Court for Somerset County, the County Commissioners of Somerset County, 5 the President of the County Commissioners of Somerset County, a member of the County 6 Roads Board of Somerset County, or the President of the County Roads Board of Somerset 7 County while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but 8 the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset 9 County, the State's Attorney for Somerset County, the Chief Judge of the Orphans' Court 10 for Somerset County, an associate judge of the Orphans' Court for Somerset County, the 11 County Commissioners of Somerset County, the President of the County Commissioners of 12 Somerset County, a member of the County Roads Board of Somerset County, or the 13 President of the County Roads Board of Somerset County shall take effect at the beginning 14 of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. 15

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
