9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
10 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 542 of the Acts of 2018

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for persons who hold a Class
13 4 limited winery license on or before June 30, 2018:

14 (1) the law in effect on June 30, 2018, continues to apply until April 30,
15 **[2022] 2024**; and

16 (2) this Act shall apply beginning on May 1, **[2022] 2024**.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect April
18 15, 2022.
