1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **General Assembly Compensation Commission – Recommendations**

3 FOR the purpose of rejecting, in accordance with the provisions of Article III, Section 15 of
4 the Maryland Constitution, items included in the Resolution of the General
5 Assembly Compensation Commission submitted and transmitted to the General
6 Assembly during the regular session of the General Assembly in 2022 relating to
7 salaries for all members of the General Assembly, the per diem allowance for meals,
8 reimbursement for lodging expenses, and travel allowances and reimbursements;
9 and generally relating to the Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation
10 Commission submitted and transmitted to the General Assembly during the regular
11 session of the General Assembly in 2022.

12 **RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:**

13 (a) In accordance with the authority granted under Article III, Section 15 of the
14 Maryland Constitution, the General Assembly rejects the recommendations included in the
15 Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission submitted and transmitted
16 to the General Assembly during the regular session of the General Assembly in 2022
17 relating to salaries for all members of the General Assembly, the per diem allowance for
18 meals, reimbursement for lodging expenses, and travel allowances and reimbursements;

21 submitted and transmitted to the General Assembly during the regular session of the
22 General Assembly in 2022 relating to salaries for all members of the General Assembly, the
23 per diem allowance for meals, reimbursement for lodging expenses, and travel allowances
24 and reimbursements shall be void and provisions related to salaries, allowances, and
25 reimbursements shall be as provided in the Resolution of the General Assembly
26 Compensation Commission dated January 7, 2014; and be it further
