## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board of License Commissioners**  
3 **– Term Limits**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a member of the Board of License Commissioners for Anne  
5 Arundel County from serving more than four consecutive terms; extending the term  
6 of a certain member of the Board; and generally relating to the Board of License  
7 Commissioners for Anne Arundel County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 11–102 and 11–201  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2016 Volume and 2021 Supplement)

13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Alcoholic Beverages

21 11–102.

22 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

3           (c)    **(1)**    The term of a member is 2 years.

4                   **(2)**    **A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN FOUR CONSECUTIVE**  
5 **TERMS.**

6           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That notwithstanding §  
7 11–202(c)(1) of the Alcoholic Beverages Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, the term  
8 of the member of the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County who was  
9 initially appointed by the Governor to the Board in 2021 shall expire on April 30, 2024.

10           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
11 1, 2022.
