A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Utilities – Transportation Network Operators – Age of Motor Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a transportation network operator from using a motor
4 vehicle that is more than a certain number of model years old to provide
5 transportation network services; and generally relating to motor vehicles used to
6 provide transportation network services.

7 BY adding to

8 Article – Public Utilities

9 Section 10–408

10 Annotated Code of Maryland

11 (2020 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Utilities**

15 **10–408.**

16 **AN OPERATOR MAY NOT USE A MOTOR VEHICLE, INCLUDING A LEASED OR**
17 **RESERVED MOTOR VEHICLE, THAT IS MORE THAN 15 MODEL YEARS OLD TO PROVIDE**
18 **TRANSPORTATION NETWORK SERVICES.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
20 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
21 been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to
22 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
23 enacted.
