Baltimore County Game & Fish Protective Association (BCG&FPA) was established in 1936. The mission of the organization is to Protect & Preserve Game, Fish, Forests and Waters in Maryland. This Association is organized to procure the enactment of suitable laws for the protection and preservation of game, fish, forests and waters within the State of Maryland and for the vigorous enforcement of such laws, and to carry out all phases of conservation, such as, education, legislation, propagation of game and fish and any other activities that may come within the true interpretation of conservation of the natural resources and wild life and shall engage in activities tending to educate and create an interest in conservation. We currently have 637 members.							

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

This project calls for the paving of the remaining old section of entrance road and the upper parking lot. The area to be paved is 17,816 SF, and will be paved with 3 1/2" asphalt by a professional and licensed paving company. This is the third and final phase of the Entrance Road Repaving Project. Phases 1 & 2 were competed in 2020. This project is needed because the parking lot is in poor shape and is hazardous. The existing asphalt is crumbling. There are numerous potholes that are causing ice to form and resulting in slippery conditions. Pedestrian and vehicular traffic is negatively impacted. Additionally, we have water runoff issues that will be corrected when the re-paving and grading is completed. The life span of the new paving is expected to be 25-30 years. This project is "shovel ready".

Baltimore County Game & Fish Protective Association (BCG&FPA) is a community oriented organization that conducts the following activities:

- We sponsor an annual "Fish Rodeo" for children. Over 250 attendees in 2021. This gives children a chance to experience outdoor recreational activities. We have our pond stocked with fish and invite children and their parents to catch fish. We provide all of the equipment, fish, food and fun at no charge to the public.
- We hold an annual Christmas party for children, again at no charge to the public.
- BCG&FPA has a large outdoor pavilion where we hold our large fund raising events. These events can attract hundreds of people, and this is why it is important to have our road and parking area re-paved.
- 2 Outdoor Shows open to the public. These are attended by hundreds of people in the Spring and Fall.
- BCG&FPA partners with the Maryland State DNR to deliver Hunter Education classes. 120 students completed this training in 2021.
- We sponsor Boy Scout Troop#247, children aged 11-17. We provide space for meetings and camp outs.
- Provide meeting space for other local organizations, e.g., Boy Scouts, Chesapeake Knife Club, etc.
- We proudly sponsored a large fundraising event to honor Officer Amy Caprio who was slain in the line of duty.
- BCG&FPA delivers approximately 10 safety-related training courses for the public annually.
- Provides recreational opportunities for members, guests, and the public across our 40 acres of property.
