Replace the gymnasium bleachers at Northern and Southern High Schools. The existing bleachers have reached their useful life expectancy and require a disproportional amount of funding to keep them operational to meet all federal, state, and local safety and inspection standards. Based on the current condition of the bleachers, the third-party inspector has shared some concerns about the possibility of the need to complete some major structural repairs. The new bleachers would also include ADA accessibility, seating, and handrail systems.
