<p>Howard L Turner (Post 276) of the American Legion was established on November 10th, 1955. Post 276 supports veterans, families, and local charities. Post 276 consists of over 1000 members made up of Legionnaires, Auxiliary and Sons of the American Legion. Post 276 supports various charities, non-profit organizations such as Womens Shelter, Boys and Cub Scouts, The Civil Air Patrol, and Disable Veterans Organization. We provide our facilities for these groups to host their meetings, training, and various other events and provide monetary donations to help support their operations. Post 276 sponsors an American Legion Baseball team. We host a yearly Fisher House fund raiser which supports families of military persons who are hospitalized. This past year over \$60,000 was raised and for the 12 years that the Post has sponsored this event, over \$526,000 was raised.</p>
