This includes case management coupled with street outreach services to the unsheltered, emergency shelter for individuals, families and those fleeing domestic violence, and various rehousing and supportive housing programs. DPW, Bureau of Facilities will administer this project. As the agency responsible for planning through construction & operations of Howard County Government buildings, BoF has the experience to provide management of these tasks as they come to realization.</p>
