AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 11
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 14, after “manner;” insert “requiring the Department of the Environment to share certain information consistently with the Maryland Department of Health and local health departments and to encourage the Maryland Department of Health and local health departments to share certain information to the online portal;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 11, after line 11, insert:

“(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) CONSISTENTLY SHARE THE INFORMATION COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION WITH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS; AND

(2) ENCOURAGE THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS TO SHARE RELEVANT INFORMATION TO THE ONLINE PORTAL.”

On page 14, after line 28, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of the Environment shall:

(1) conduct a study on long-term funding options for the detailed monitoring and analysis of groundwater resources in the State;

(2) on or before December 1, 2025, submit a report of its findings and recommendations for long-term funding options under paragraph (1) of this section to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly; and

(3) assist in identifying a funding source for a private well grant fund.”;

and in line 29, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
