AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 102
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “**License – Exemption**” and substitute “**Gear – Individuals Under the Age of 16 Years**”; and strike beginning with “exempting” in line 3 down through “license” in line 7 and substitute “authorizing an individual under a certain age to use certain gear when catching or attempting to catch crabs for recreational purposes without a recreational crabbing license; and generally relating to recreational crabbing”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 17 through 20, inclusive, and substitute:

“AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS CATCHING OR ATTEMPTING TO CATCH CRABS IN THE WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES WITHOUT A RECREATIONAL CRABBING LICENSE MAY USE A COLLAPSIBLE TRAP OR NET RING, AS DESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN REGULATIONS.”
